THE PILLAR OF TRUTH



One of the core responsibilities of the church today is to uphold the truth of the Gospel. This is made plain when Paul writes in 1st Timothy 3:15 that “I write so that you will know how one ought to conduct himself in the household of God, which is the church of the living God, the pillar and support of the truth.” NASB Paul uses the image of the pillar as a symbol of strength and stability for the mystery of the Gospel.

Sometimes, in the ancient world, pillars were used to support temples to false gods. Such was the case in Judges 16:23-31, where the Philistines assembled to offer a sacrifice to their god Dagon and make sport of their captive Samson. As 3,000 people looked on, Samson called upon the Lord one last time.

²⁹ “Samson grasped the two middle pillars on which the house rested, and braced himself against them, the one with his right hand and the other with his left. ³⁰... And he bent with all his might so that the house fell on the lords and all the people who were in it.” NASB

As members of the church, we too must be the pillars that support the household of God.

Pillars can be used to support the truth or falsehood. The church must be steadfast to maintain and promote the truth, much like the church in Philadelphia. Revelation 3:12 ¹² ‘He who overcomes, I will make him a pillar in the temple of My God, and he will not go out from it anymore; and I will write on him the name of My God, and the name of the city of My God, the new Jerusalem, which comes down out of heaven from My God, and My new name. NASB

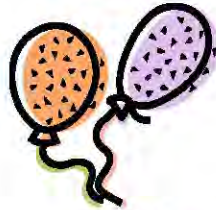
As members of the church, we too must be the pillars that support the household of God.

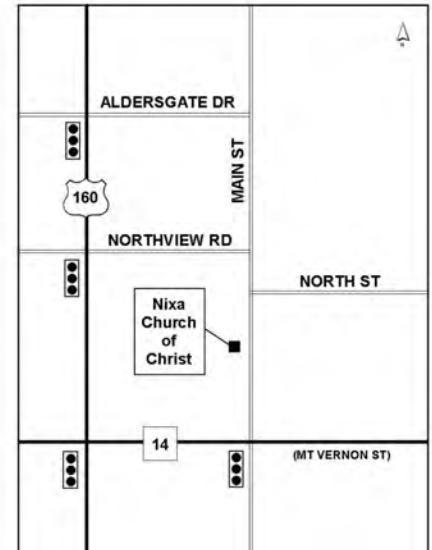
