Forgiveness

“Be kindly affectionate to one another with brotherly love, in honor giving preference to one another.” (Romans 12:10) “And be kind to one another tender hearted, forgiving one another, even as God in Christ forgave you.” (Ephesians 4:32).

Everyday is hard and a challenge, sometimes it is hard to be “The bigger person” but that is what Jesus Christ was. Let’s look at how Christ was forgiving. 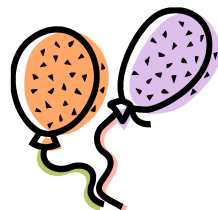

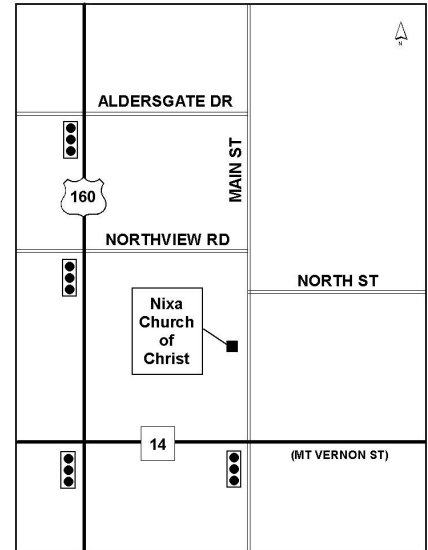
