The Full Armor of God

“Finally, be strong in the Lord and in the strength of His might. Put on the full armor of God, so that you will be able to stand firm against the schemes of the devil. For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the powers, against the world forces of this darkness, against the spiritual forces of wickedness in the heavenly places.” (Eph. 6:10-12).

To win a fight, you must first identify your enemy, then defend yourself, and finally take control. In our country's long history of wars, the Vietnam War stands out as one of the most difficult and complicated episodes. The enemy was difficult to locate and fight because they were hiding in the thick bush and using guerilla tactics. During the day these soldiers would be dressed as regular farmers working diligently in the fields, then at night they would become soldiers ambushing their enemy. It was difficult for the Americans to know who the enemy was. Morale was low among American troops, and most people were strongly against the war.

There are similarities between this type of war and the one we are waging. Satan moves quietly, like a roaring lion on the hunt. He is constantly looking for someone to devour (1 Pet. 5:8), but he is also sneaky and cunning. He sends people to work for him who pretend to be apostles of Christ and servants of righteousness (2 Cor. 11:13–15). Awareness and perception are needed to understand them and protect yourself from their threats.

However, many people don't believe in the supernatural or spiritual battle, which makes them powerless. They think Satan is a popular figure for movies and books, but only stupid and superstitious people really believe in him. Sadly, many Christians have rolled over due to ridicule.

Ephesians 6:10–24 tells us that we have everything we need to protect ourselves and defeat evil. You should always remember Ephesians 6:11, which says, "Put on the full armor of God, so that you will be able to stand firm against the schemes of the devil." I hope that this reminder has given you strength for the next battle. Ask God for knowledge and grace to help you see your enemy clearly and face them with courage.

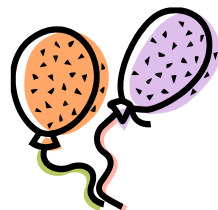

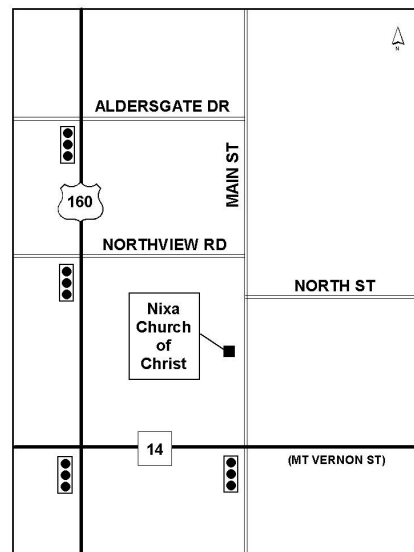
