Believe the Bible

Sometimes I wonder if we appreciate the Scriptures as we should. We have the God given record of the past, and true information regarding His will and our destiny.

On the west bank of the Nile in Egypt there stands the village of Arabat el Madfurnah (literally translated "Arabat the buried"). Through the centuries of time the drifting sands of Egypt have buried many of its monuments, marvelous structures and ancient treasures of engravings, stone works and art, much of the time.

We believe this to be the ancient city of Thinis, the cradle of the earliest Egyptian dynasty, and dedicated to the cult of the legendary god Osiris. 
