With all the myths and imaginary legends and stories about God, how much of the truth would we really know with certainty without the Bible containing the God-inspired Scriptures? How could we be sure of the creation story? The Lord's handiwork is to be seen all around us, but unbelievers endeavor to persuade men that it wasn't a matter of creation but evolution, and without knowledge of the Scriptures many are deceived.

Without the Scriptures how could we even start to comprehend the depth and the mercy of God's grace and love? Though the writings of history record the crucifixion of Christ, would we without the Scriptures have understood that He was the eternal Son of God, and it was for our sins that He died? Would we have ever believed that He came from heaven, was born of a virgin into the human family? Would we ever have known of His eternal existence just through the observations and writings of men?

We are forever indebted to God for the inspiration, preservation and existence of the Scriptures. Without them, we would be groping for information. What knowledge would we have concerning death and eternity? From antiquity men have believed in life after death. Thomas D. Dennis November 14, 1928 - July 14, 2024

From 1947, the year he was baptized at Mount Ayr, IA, Tom began preaching the gospel and continued that work for the rest of his life, a total of 75 years. He started congregations, held meetings and vacation Bible studies through the central midwestern states, eventually across the United States. He also led six study tours of the Bible lands. In 2004 he retired from the traveling evangelist life and moved to Nixa where he and wife Ann placed membership. He was appointed as an Elder for the congregation in 2009. His enthusiasm for sharing the gospel never waned. We mourn his loss but rejoice in heaven's gain.

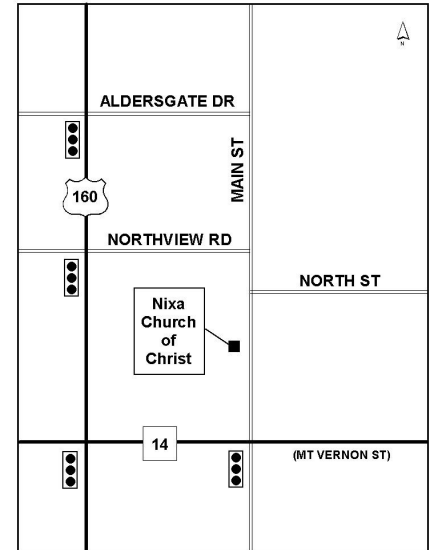
