## ***Believe, Trust, Obey, Grow, Endure***

“Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ and you will be saved.” (Acts 16:31) “Without faith it is impossible to please Him, (God) for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.” (Hebrews 11:6) Jesus said, “You believe in God, believe also in Me.” (John 14:1) “No one comes to the Father except through Me.” (John 14:6) “Nor is there salvation in any other, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved.” (Acts 4:12)

Belief or faith that saves depends on our knowledge and understanding of the Word of God, the Holy Scriptures, and our willingness to submit and comply accordingly. We must believe to the extent that we will trust, knowing that God’s word and promises are true.

Realizing the reality of God’s love and grace, and the reward He offers to those who sincerely and wholeheartedly yield to Him, we obey His commandments. We repent of our sins as it is written. “Repent therefore and be converted that your sins may be blotted out.” (Acts 3:19) “God --- commands all men everywhere to repent.” (Acts 17:30) “Repent and let everyone of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins.” (Acts 2:38) “Arise, and be baptized and wash away your sins, calling on the name of the Lord.” (Acts 22:16)

Some people have said that baptism is not necessary. Others have said babies should be sprinkled. Still others have taught baptism is for people who have been saved. The Scriptures plainly teach baptism is burial (Colossians 2:12, Romans 6:4) in water (Acts 8:38-39, 10:47) “for the remission of sins” (Acts 2:38) and in so doing the person is “born again” (John 3:3-7) and “he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold all things have become new” (2 Corinthians 5:17) with peace of mind that the guilt of sins is all taken away, and that in Christ we have a Savior “who is even at the right hand of God who also makes intercession for us.” (Romans 8:34)

He who sincerely believes in Christ is not ashamed to confess his faith, before or after being baptized. “I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God.” (Acts 8:37) “For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. (Romans 10:10) After one is saved, let him be “not ashamed of the gospel of Christ.” (Romans 1:16) Jesus said, “Therefore, whoever confesses Me before men, him I will also confess before My Father who is in Heaven.” (Matthew 10:32)

After one becomes a Christian, we have the responsibility to study, (2 Timothy 2:15, Acts 17:11) learn and grow, (2 Peter 3:18) and be faithful; (Revelation 2:10) persevering and enduring to the end. (Matthew 24:13) Heaven will be worth it all!


