TIME FOR TEARS

“To everything there is a season, a time for every purpose under heaven – a time to weep – a time to mourn. (Ecclesiastes 3) These were Solomon’s words, but for the greater portion of his life Solomon may never have experienced a great deal of sorrow and weeping. For most of his life, people might say “He had everything going his way.” But he was realistic enough to know that sad times do come in this earth life. And after Solomon “turned from the Lord (1 Kings 11), his real problems began, and it must have been a crushing blow when the Lord informed him “I will surely tear the kingdom from you.” And we know the rest of the story, how after Solomon’s death, the ten tribes submitted to Jeroboam and heathen idolatry.

When we think of a time for weeping and mourning, we surely think of the days of Jeremiah, truly one of the greatest of the Hebrew prophets, sometimes referred to as the weeping prophet and quoted at different times in the New Testament. He lived in miserable times. The ruthless slaughter of people during the reign of Manasseh, the decline of the Hebrew society, the rise of Babylon under Nabopolassar and Nebuchadnezzar, the fall of Jerusalem, the destruction of the temple, his own imprisonment and torture. Those were sad times.

There were the burdens of sorrow in the earth life of our Savior, “a man of sorrows and acquainted with grief.” (Isaiah 53:3) He was moved with compassion. He wept with those who wept. He wept over the city of Jerusalem, knowing the doom and destruction that would come to that city within a lifetime after His death. He foretold the “great tribulation.” (Matthew 24:21) Unequaled previously or ever after.

As we review history we think of the times that efforts have been made to annihilate the Jewish people, the Christians. Men like the ancient Antiochus Epiphanes and the more modern Adolf Hitler stained the pages of history with slaughter and the blood of humans.

“But know this, that in the last days perilous times will come.” (2 Timothy 3:1) Regardless of what comes, be faithful to the Lord even unto death. Heaven will be worth it all, and “God will wipe away every tear.” (Revelation 21:4)


