Believe and Obey

When Jesus Christ was born in Bethlehem of Judea there was no local radio station to announce it, or any Bethlehem Newspaper to report it. There probably was not even a town bulletin board at that early date. But the news did spread. Angels from heaven told the shepherds and "When they had seen Him, they made widely known the saying which was told them concerning this Child." (Luke 2:17) But we are not told whether there was anybody but Joseph and Mary who knew that He was born of a virgin..

King Herod the Great learned that a King was born in Bethlehem and in his jealousy for power commanded that little boys of Bethlehem be put to death. Did he ever know that the one he sought to destroy was born of a virgin? Would it have made any difference in his cruel thinking?

Nothing is recorded as having been said about Christ's birth in His boyhood discussion with the scholars at the temple, but they marveled at the questions and statements of a twelve year old boy. During the entire life of Jesus on earth there is no Biblical record of Him ever telling anyone of His having been born of a virgin. Those who knew the Scriptures could see that He seemed to fulfill many of the prophecies, but did any in His vast audiences make any connection with this one who taught with authority, this miracle worker who walked on water, who healed the sick and raised the dead, as being the one promised by the prophets,?

Yes, some asked "Could this be the Christ?" He was of the lineage of David. He was from Nazareth. But in the synagogue at Capernaum when He read a passage from Isaiah that applied to Himself, His own countrymen attempted to kill Him. Eventually, at the demand of a mob in Jerusalem, Pilate gave consent for His crucifixion. He died for our sins. He rose from the dead and ascended to heaven, fulfilling ALL the prophecies concerning Him. And yet there are still many who do not obey Him.

Many celebrate the two national holidays commemorating His birth and His resurrection, and yet fail to obey His will and repent and be baptized. When He comes again every knee shall bow and every tongue confess. but for many too late for salvation.

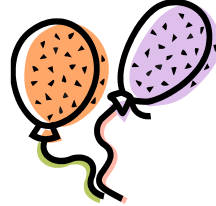

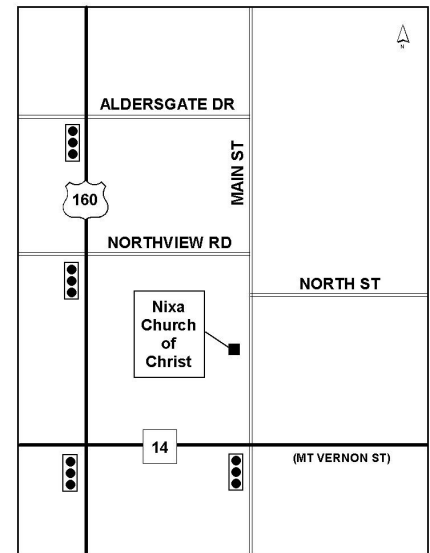
