From the Manger to the Cross about 5 or 6 Miles Away

Stepping down from the splendor and glory of heaven to the earth that He had created when time began, to live among mortal descendants of the couple He created centuries before, on the sixth day of creation, and even taking a body like that of the descendants, subject to human death, and without the sexual union of a man and woman, He entered the earth life by a virgin. He was the Son of God.

And what a place for the Son of God to be born! In a shelter for animals! And regardless of how well we know the story, we cannot but stand in awe and amazement that the prophets foretold centuries earlier the virgin birth and even the town where He would be born, and other bits and pieces of information such as the fact that one before Him would prepare the way for Him. Who but God could have moved the prophets to foretell such details long before they transpired?

The world did not know Him. King Herod the Great wanted to kill Him. People in His home town of Nazareth wanted to throw Him over a cliff. At different times during His approximate three years of ministry men attempted to seize Him, and he passed from them. His time was not yet.

For three years He lovingly taught and pleaded for men to repent and live righteously. He lived absolutely sinlessly. Though He was tempted in all points, even as we are tempted, He did no sin.

But when the proper time came, and the Jewish leaders had plotted to destroy Him, and the Roman government was using crucifixion as a death penalty for criminals, the time had come. He returned to Jerusalem, where He had taught openly in the temple, and where he had healed many, knowing full well that He would be betrayed, abused and crucified.

And they crucified Him, not knowing at that time, that they were crucifying the Son of God, who came to give His life and be the one sacrifice forever through whom men could be forgiven and saved from eternal hell.

Let men now believe in Christ, repent of sins, be baptized and live godly lives in reverence and fear.

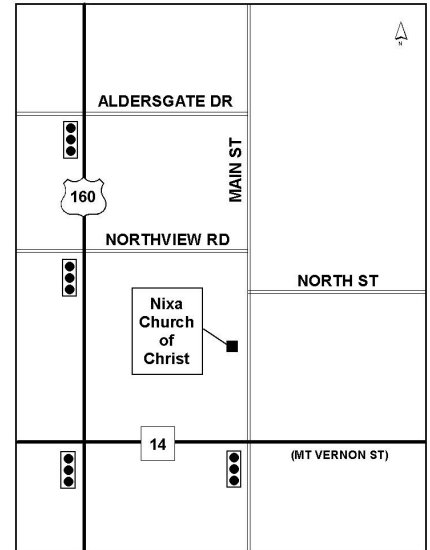
