The Wise and Foolish Builders

Jesus often spoke in parables. About 1/3 of all Jesus teaching was in the form of parables. Jesus took earthly situations that the hearer could relate to and beside it laid down a parallel spiritual meaning. The word means "to place beside, or to cast alongside." It puts the known next to the unknown so that learning can take place. It can usually be identified by use of the word "like". Those that had open hearts could often easily understand the meaning. Those that had closed hearts or minds probably would not.

In his "Sermon on the Mount" Jesus described what is blessed in the sight of God, a new kingdom not of this world, a new covenant between God and man, and how a godly person should think, act, speak, and pray. He said "seek first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all the things you will need in this world will be added to you" Matt 6:33. He also said "Not every one who says to me 'Lord, Lord,' will enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that does the will of my Father" Matt 7:21.

Then Jesus said, "Therefore whoever hears these sayings of Mine, and does them, I will liken him to a wise man who built his house on the rock: and the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew and beat on that house; and it did not fall: for it was founded on the rock. But everyone who hears these sayings of mine, and does not do them, will be like a foolish man, who built his house on the sand: and the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew and beat on that house; and it fell: and great was its fall." Matt 7:24-27

So what was Jesus parallel spiritual meaning? Was he talking about home building or life building? Whoever hears the word of God has a choice. He or she can act wisely and seek to do God's will, or act foolishly and follow their own will. A wise man would build on the rock that is the almighty God.

David said "The Lord is my rock and my deliverer; My God, my strength, in whom I will trust;" Ps 18:2. What is stronger than solid rock? We sing "On Christ the solid rock I stand, all other ground is sinking sand." David also prophesied that "The stone which the builders rejected has become the chief cornerstone. Ps 118:22.

Peter referred to this prophecy when speaking to Jewish leaders in Acts 4:10-12, "let it be known to you, and to all the people of Israel; Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom you crucified, whom God raised from the dead, this is the stone which was rejected by you builders, which has become the chief cornerstone. Nor is there salvation in any other, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved." The Jewish leaders were building in the sand. Jesus had told Peter that "upon this rock I will build my church, and the gates of Hades shall not prevail against it." Matt 16:18. This rock was the fact just spoken by Peter, that he believed "Jesus was the Christ, the Son of the living God." Paul said "For no other foundation can anyone lay than that which is laid, which is Jesus Christ" I Cor 3:11.

When we hear the word of God and are obedient to it we are wisely building on the best foundation for life both now and in eternity. Our lives should be built around the two great commandments of Jesus: "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind. This is the first and great commandment. And the second is like it: You shall love your neighbor as yourself." Matt 27:37-39.

The foolish man would hear the word of God but choose to follow their own will. Jesus said "Do not lay up for yourselves treasures on earth, but in heaven, where neither moth nor rust destroys and where thieves do not break in and steal." Matt 6:19-20. Are we not flooded daily with the temptations of this world? If we don't dig deeply into God's word and understand his plan for us will we not be swept away by sin? Build wisely, it will be worth it!


